Office team

We operate with a very efficient and dedicated office team ranging from our accounts department, to vetting and screening and also our dedicated sales team. Which provides us with the confidence that we have the infrastructure in place to manage your every need.





Dedicated Contract Manager

Due to the need for close control over contracts which encompass multiple sites and/or large numbers of security operatives operating over a given weekly period it is our policy to appoint a single member of management to have overall operational control of the contract for the duration of its operation.

The Contract Manager will be responsible for the rostering of guards for the contract period who will be taken from our database of over 150 licensed guards and for the recruitment of additional suitable guards as the contract dictates.

In the event that there are staff who currently work at the venues that Unit Management would like to retain we would be willing to take these staff on subject to successful security screening in compliance with BS7858.

To do this we would need to establish whether the current supplier has any clauses within their current contract making this unworkable. In some cases suppliers will include a clause stating the client is not permitted to recruit said suppliers staff for their unit for a fixed period after the cessation of the contract.

Site Assessments

For the first four (4) weeks after take over we will ensure that the Contracts Manager, or a suitable member of senior management, visits the units in question to ensure operational policies and procedures are being adhered to.

Subsequent visits to site would be performed on a monthly basis if and as required by the client.





RECRUITMENT & SELECTION

Guards are recruited through job advertisements placed local to the client premises and through local press advertisements.

Interviews will be conducted by a panel which will include the Contracts Manager and a senior member of company management.

During the selection process each guard is required to complete a Skills Test relative to the role they will be performing within any given contract.

Once a detailed Interview Assessment has been reviewed by the panel, each applicant, who passes the initial interview stage is subject to a stringent 5 years vetting process which includes a full work history clarification, criminality check and residential history check to confirm identity and references.

Once selected each successful applicant will be given a full and comprehensive company induction coupled with a full site induction for each clients site they will be required to work at.

Staff Development

Through our Management Team all staff will be subject to periodic training and evaluation in line with company procedures to ensure they are fully aware of changes in both legislation and best working practice for the role they will be expected to perform.

Each guard will also take part in a bi-annual appraisal process to evaluate their individual training needs and to agree performance related targets for the following period.

We have also instigated a system of staff incentives based on performance to reward aspects of work such as time and attendance, code of conduct, and performance within their role. These incentives will take the form of monetary incentives and/or staff events to raise morale and develop a team building work ethic within the corporate structure.

SUMMARY

Below is an overview of our terms of contract:

Dedicated Contract Manager

No less than 2 weeks prior to takeover we will need to perform a site visit and risk assessment of each unit

A 4 week lead period prior to take over to assess suitability of staff for each unit & to complete any required recruitment

Site Assessments for the first four (4) weeks after take over we will ensure that the Contracts Manager, or a suitable member of senior management, visits the site in question once a week during operating times to ensure operational policies and procedures are being adhered to.

Subsequent visits to site will be performed on a monthly basis

Management Reviews with each unit performed at the same time

Operational Systems compliant with BS7499, BS7960 & BS7858

Standard hourly rates are negotiated per contract and dependent on geographical location and shift breakdown

All invoices will be subject to VAT at standard rate
